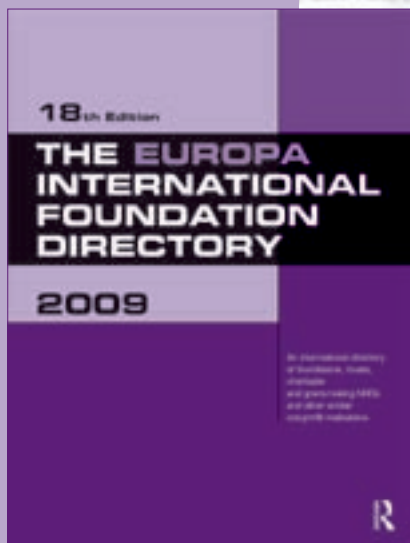

PART 1

Essays provide valuable background information on the sector, giving an overview world-wide, as well as detailing the direction in which foundations and NGOs are moving. Professor Helmut Anheier gives an overview of foundations and the third sector. A piece for this edition, on the impact of the global economic problems on the third sector, of the University of Warwick explores the debate surrounding civil society.

PART 2

Entries are arranged alphabetically, and are listed within individual countries, providing the following details:

- Directory information, including the name of the organization, postal address, telephone and fax numbers, where applicable.
- Full details of the date of establishment and the aims and function of the organization, as well as its principal activities: projects and programmes, awards, scholarships, etc., listed along with the geographical area of activity, finances, key executives.
- Foundation centres and co-ordinating bodies are listed in a separate section. These include CAF (Charities Aid Foundation, UK), Civil Society International (USA), Charités (Belgium).

Entries listed include:

Polish-Czech-Slovak Solidarity Foundation, The Bill and Melinda Gates Foundation, Marie Curie Cancer Cure and Médecins sans Frontières.

PART 3

Comprehensive indexes are provided, listing foundations alphabetically, by region: Middle East, Western Europe, Central and South America and the Caribbean (e.g. education, medicine and health, social welfare, etc.).

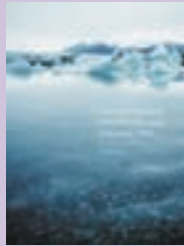

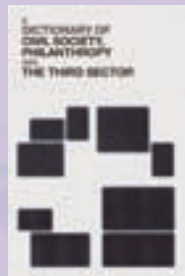
